REVIEW THE PROGRAMS

Research programs early in order to find one that fits your needs and would be a beneficial experience for you. The exact program you choose will shape the essays you'll write for your study abroad application.

BRAINSTORM IDEAS

There are 3 main essays for your application. They deal with the academic goals your program will help you achieve, what extracurriculars you hope to be involved in, and how ready you are for the challenges of studying abroad.



START WRITING

Once you have formulated your ideas, start drafting your essays. Don't be afraid of the blank page. Write your thoughts down on paper first so that you can revise them later.

APPLICATION WRITING TIPS

When writing for an application it is important to remember to be direct, concise, organized, confident, and reader-friendly. Your audience is someone who is reading a lot of applications quickly and you want to stand out.



VISIT THE HUB
